Please find the attached spreadsheet submitted by the Kansas Turnpike Authority and completed pursuant to KSA 77-440(b)(2). As you can see from the attached spreadsheet, the Kansas Turnpike Authority has identified the following regulations for revocation. Most of these regulations are entirely traffic related, unnecessary and duplicative of other state laws used by the Kansas Highway Patrol to police the turnpike.

K.A.R. 39-1-3	Waste and rubbish
K.A.R. 39-1-4	Damage to property
K.A.R. 39-1-5	Alcoholic beverages, gambling and weapons
K.A.R. 39-1-10	Uniform direction of traffic
K.A.R. 39-1-13	Driving in traffic lane, overtaking and passing
K.A.R. 39-1-15	Accidents
K.A.R. 39-1-17	Following too closely
