Agricultural Remediation Board

KAR 125-1-7, eligible correction action costs; exclusions.

The Committee had no comments.

Department of Health and Environment, Division of Environment, Bureau of Waste Management

KAR 28-29-2008, coal combustion residual (CCR) facility permit renewal fees.

Request. The Committee requests the agency provide additional information regarding whether the amount of coal ash produced and disposed of in Kansas has changed over the past five years and whether there has been measurable change in the amounts or proportions of heavy metals or other contaminants contained within such coal ash.
