Subprogram History			
In 1976, K.S.A. 74-7001 was established by the Legislature to create the Board of Technical Professions by combining the Engineering Examiners Registration Board (including Land Surveyors), the Architects Registration Board, and the Landscape Architects Registration Board. K.S.A. 74-7004 provides that the purpose of the Board of Technical Professions is to establish and maintain a high standard of integrity, skills, and practice in the technical professions and to safeguard the life, health, property and welfare of the public. The Board is authorized to collect licensing fees, renewal fees, and other fees as necessary to adminster provisions of K.S.A. 74-7001 et. seq. In 1980, K.S.A. 74-7036 was established by the Legislature outlining the practice of technical professions by a business entity, applications for certificate of authorizations, renewals, fees, and liability of services performed. In the 1997 Legislature, H.B. 2490 created the licensing of geologists starting July 1, 2000, by the Board of Technical Professions.			
Consequences of Not Funding This Subprogram			
If this program was not funded there would be no regulation of professional individual and business licensure for Engineers, Architects, Surveyors, Landscape Architects, and Geologists.
