The Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training (KS CPOST), located in Wichita, Kansas, is a regulatory body that provides the citizens of Kansas with qualified, trained, and professional peace officers. It is also dedicated to adopting and enforcing professional standards for certification of peace officers to promote public safety and preserve public trust. The KS CPOST maintains a central registry of law enforcement officers' demographics, qualifications, and employment history, which is made available to agencies when reviewing employment applications. KS CPOST conducts administrative investigations related to violations of the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Act<sup>1</sup> and may suspend, revoke, or deny certification of a law enforcement officer.

## Agency

The **agency** requests a revised estimate of \$1.2 million, all from special revenue funds, and 7.0 FTE positions in FY 2026. This is a decrease of \$6,982, or 0.6 percent, below the amount approved by the 2025 Legislature. This decrease is largely due to a decrease of \$20,046, all from the KS CPOST Fund, in salaries and wages as the 2025 Legislature approved the addition of 1.0 FTE position for a new full-time investigator position that the agency did not fill until the end of July 2025. This decrease was partially offset by an increase of \$13,064 in aid to locals expenditures from the Local Law Enforcement Training Reimbursement Fund, due to reimbursements to municipal agencies being higher than anticipated.

### Agency

The **agency** requests \$1.2 million, all from special revenue funds, and 7.0 FTE positions for FY 2027. This is an increase of \$9,846, or 0.8 percent, above the amount approved by the 2025 Legislature. This increase is largely due to an increase of \$13,604 in aid to locals expenditures due to an increase in reimbursements to municipal agencies and an increase of \$11,635 for increased expenditures across all categories. These increases were partially offset by a decrease of \$15,393 in salaries and wages expenditures to better match FY 2026 expenditures.
